Eligibility

- ✓ High school seniors graduating in June and college freshmen returning to school in the Fall (age 17-25)
- ✓ GPA of 2.0 3.5
- ✓ One-Time eligibility
- ✓ Completed application (online or by mail)
- 500 word essay on "What is an Entrepreneur?" (Times New Roman, 12pt, Single indent)
- ✓ Attend the Dinner at the Ron Brown/Aubry Stone Memorial Economic Conference in Sacramento, California on Friday August 16, 2019 or have a parent/guardian attend in your place. Failure to attend will disqualify you from receiving the scholarship.

Application

Fill out the application completely. Incomplete applications will not be accepted. Print neatly.

Official Transcript, Proof of Enrollment, College Acceptance Letter

<u>High School Student</u>: Submit one official high school transcript. It should include the courses you have taken, your grades, and GPA.

College Freshman: Submit your college transcript and proof of enrollment and /or your college acceptance letter.

Letter of Recommendation

Everyone must include two (2) letters of recommendation from a guidance counselor, teacher, coach, clergy or another adult who knows you but is not a family member.

Essay

Complete a 500 word essay on "What is an Entrepreneur?" All essays must be typed and doubled spaced. The California Black Chamber is about encouraging small business entrepreneurship. Even though you may not be interested in becoming an entrepreneur you should know and understand what it means to be one. Being an entrepreneur may give you one more options to consider.
